**Boys and Girls Club** enriches the lives of children ages 6 – 18 in Waukegan, IL by providing programs that offer a safe place to learn and grow and teach. It also provides life-enhancing programs and character development opportunities.

**Rainbows** is a non-profit organization that offers peer support groups for children who are grieving a death, divorce, or any other painful transition in their family. The groups are led by trained, adult facilitators.



**I Have A Dream** consists of a defined group of children “adopted” from a public school or public housing development, their sponsor, First Presbyterian Church of Lake Forest, and community partners who provide services to the group. It is a discrete entity that operates from the point the children are “adopted” when they are in elementary school, until they graduate from high school.
